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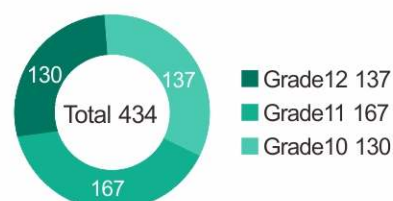

Curricula

The International Department offers two academic programs:

International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP)

IB program requires students to complete pre-IB courses in Grade 10 as an academic preparation for the IBDP. In Grade 11-12, students should complete three higher level courses (HL) and three standard level courses (SL), selected from six disciplines. Students should also fulfill the requirements of Creativity, Activity and Service (CAS), Theory of Knowledge (TOK), and the Extended Essay (EE). The language of instruction is English, except Chinese A Language and Literature.

Advanced Placement (AP) Program

The AP program offers the American Curriculum based on the American Common Core Standards and the Chinese National Curriculum (CNC). The CNC courses are conducted in Chinese, while all other courses are conducted in English. Students enrolled in the AP program can choose one of the following tracks: the Chinese Regular Senior High School Diploma Track or the US High School Diploma Track.

The US High School Diploma Track is endorsed, supported, and audited for quality by our partner school St. Mary's School in Medford, Oregon, United States. Students who meet the graduation requirements will be eligible to receive the High School Diploma from St. Mary's School.

The graduation requirements for the two tracks are as follows:
