SCHOOL PROFILE 2016-2017

Overview

Chengdu Shude High School is located in Chengdu, one of the largest cities in Southwestern China. Since its founding in 1929, Shude has grown into the largest public school and one of the best three leading secondary education institutions in Chengdu. Shude provides an education to about 8300 students ranging from Grade 7 to 12 studying across 3 campuses. Every year, over 80% of the Chinese National Curriculum (CNC) graduates are accepted into Tier 1 universities in China, including Peking University and Tsinghua University.

In 2002, the International Department was founded to explore the international education. It started to offer the Victorian Certificate of Education(VCE) courses in 2004, introduced the Sino-US Program in 2011 and gained the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program(IBDP) authorization in 2012. Shude International aims to nurture talents with global vision advancing towards the world. So far, over 2453 graduates have been sent to prestigious universities around the world, while 80% of them are enrolled in US colleges and the rest are enrolled in famous universities in the UK, Canada, Australia, Singapore and others countries.

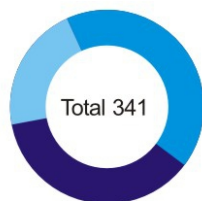

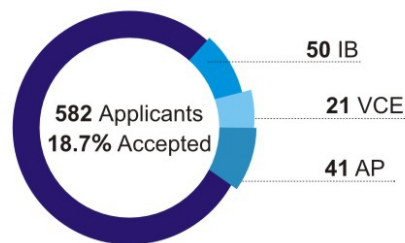

Admission Requirements

The Shude International Department admits applicants based on their Zhongkao (High School Entrance Exam) scores, combined with holistic review over students' academic records, personalities, and interview performance.

Academic Programs

The International Department offers 3 academic programs to the enrolled students as follows:

■ **The International Baccalaureate Diploma Program (IBDP)**

As an IB world school, the school provides pre-IB courses to students in Grade 10 as an academic preparation for IBDP. Starting from Grade 11, students begin their IBDP study, including six courses selected from the six subject groups and the three core elements TOK, EE, CAS . The language of instruction for the IB program is English.

■ **The Victorian Certificate of Education Program (VCE)**

It is a joint-education program run by Haileybury College in Australia and Chengdu Shude High School accredited by the VCAA (Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority). The program requires students to complete both CNC for Chinese high school diplomas, which is instructed in Chinese, and the VCE Unit 3&4 courses for Australian VCE certificates which is instructed in English. The ratio of CNC courses to VCE courses is 1:4.

■ **The Sino-US Program**

The Program requires students to complete the Chinese National Curriculum (CNC) courses, along with the AP courses provided during the year 11 & year 12 as selective course options. The language of instruction for the program is bilingual with the CNC courses in Chinese and the AP courses in English.

- **Mathematics:** Mathematics HL&SL
- **The arts:** Visual Arts HL

The Three core elements: Theory of Knowledge (TOK); The extended essay(EE); Creativity, activity, service(CAS)

Compulsory AP Courses: Macroeconomics, Calculus AB/BC, Statistics

Other AP Courses Available: English Language and Composition, Physics, Chemistry (Require students to choose one among them)
